Take your connecting flight to Bloemfontein.


#### ARRIVING AT THE BRAM FISCHER INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT BLOEMFONTEIN


# GETTING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF THE FREE STATE

All the accommodation is within walking distance from the main gate of the UFS. Although it is safe to walk in groups during the day, it is not recommended after dark. The following arrangements have been made.

### Free State National Botanical Garden

The Free State National Botanical Garden, on the outskirts of Bloemfontein, sits perfectly between a valley and the dolerite hills. Enjoy the tall grassland or the woodlands that are dominated by the wild olive and karee trees. The botanical gardens are home to about 400 species of plants, mostly from the Free State, Northern Cape, and Lesotho areas. The natural areas of the Garden are a haven for wildlife, including 144 bird species, 54 reptile species, and about 32 mammal species. Some of which can be observed on a regular basis. Spend time hiking or relaxing on the manicured lawns, and fall asleep in the warmth of the sun.

## **ELECTRICITY**

For South Africa, there are four associated plug types, types C, D, M and N. Plug type C is the plug which has two round pins, plug type D is the plug which has three round pins in a triangular pattern and plug types M and N both have three round pins. South Africa operates on a 230V supply voltage and 50Hz. It will be in your best interest to plan ahead and bring an adaptor with. For more information, you can visit the following website:

# MONEY EXCHANGE

South Africa's currency is the rand (R), divided into 100 cents. The notes are R10, R20, R50, R100 and R200; the coins are R1, R2 and R5, and five, 10, 20 and 50 cents. Transactions are often rounded up or down by a few cents. Cash is readily exchanged at banks and foreign exchange bureaus in the big cities or the OR Tambo airport.

### The nearest exchange bureau is located at the Mimosa Mall.

Given that Bloemfontein is a smaller town, opportunities to exchange money are limited. ATMs are available on the UFS campus. Banking hours are from 9:00-15:30 on Mondays to Fridays. On Saturdays, banks are open from 9:00-12:30. Banks are closed on Sundays.

Debit or credit cards can be used at hotels, shops and businesses. However, please remember, if you plan to use a credit card in South Africa, contact your bank before leaving home and inform them of your travel plans to avoid having your purchases declined automatically.

### When shopping at small or informal craft markets, it is best to use cash.

There are ATM's available on the UFS campus.

Always take care of your belongings and ensure that you keep your money in a safe place. Please take note of your surroundings before withdrawing money. Don't trust any strangers when withdrawing money.

## TRAVEL INSURANCE

It is strongly recommended that participants take out their own general travel insurance. It is suggested that the insurance policy covers loss of fees/deposit, airfares, accommodation charges, medical expenses, loss or damage to personal property and repatriation expenses.

# WEATHER

Chilly weather lingers in July. Despite the cold temperatures, low chances of snowfall persist, with the probability at only 0.1%. Sunny days remain a key characteristic of July.

Bloemfontein marks the onset of July with an average high temperature of 16.5°C. Bloemfontein observes a substantial disparity between daytime high and the average low temperature of 1.3°C during July nights.
